This may certifie that by virtue of a warrant from the Comission of Property dated the first day of the 3d month in the year 1717 there was resurvey'd for Anthony Morris on the fourth day of the fifth month then next ensuing a certain tract of land in County of Philadelphia formerly laid out to Sarah Hersent for five hundred acres beginning at a hickery tree at a corner of Whitpain's Township or so reputed, Thence by the said Township North East four hundred perches to a corner marked White Oak. Then North West by a line of marked trees two hundred perches to a post. Then south West by a line of marked trees four hundred and eighty perches to post in a line of Eilberts Mannor. Then South East by the said Mannor two hundred perches. The North East eighty perches to the place of beginning containing six hundred acres.
