



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the tenth day February 1732/3 Surveyd and laid out the same day to James Logan of Stenton Esq<sup>r</sup> in part of two Thousand Acres the Original Purchase of W<sup>m</sup> Lloyd and Abraham Lloyd late of the City of Bristol a Tract of Land in the Township of Solebury in the County of Bucks Beginning at a black Oak in a Line of John Buy's Land Thence by the same and John Scarbrough's Land North West two hundred and fifty Perches to a White Oak Thence North East by the Land late Jacob Holcott's three hundred & twenty Perches to a black Oak Sapling Thence South East by Robert Heath's Land two hundred & fifty Perches to two black Oak Saplings Thence by the said Robert Heath's Land and other Land South West three hundred and twenty Perches to the place of Beginning Containing five Hundred Acres
