I therefore desire thee to give Jeremiah thy Ord^r to John Gutler to Survey in y^e County of Bucks the said quantity of Two thousand Acres in right of Edward Bettris of Oxford Purchaser of the like quantity by vertue of y^e Comm^{rs} Warr^{ts} dat: 30th 5^{mo} 1712 and make Returns distinctly for one thousand to the said Jeremiah and the other to me. Philad^a 24th 7^{mo} 1713.
