



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Commission^{rs} to me directed bearing date the 30th day of the 9th month 1702 to survey and lay out unto James Logan 500 acres of land in Bucks County in Right of John Tatham's purchase of 5000 acres; Locating the same on a parcel of Land adjoining on the Proprietaries near the great Spring, appropriated to him in the year 1701 by Thomas Fairman; Surveyed unto the s^d James Logan the aforesaid parcel of Land Beginning at a White Oak marked for a Corner in John Scarborough's line, Thence by the s^d Scarborough's and vacant Land North West 250. perches to a black oak marked for a Corner, Thence by vacant Land North East 324. perches to a Post by a black oak, Thence South East by vacant Land ^{Land} 250. perches to a black oak Sapling, Thence South West by the Proprietaries Land at great Spring 324. perches to the place of beginning containing five hundred acres, Situate in Soulbury Township in the County of Bucks, Surveyed and laid out the Eighth day of the Tenth Month 1702
