Whereas Nicholas Moore former President of y<sup>e</sup> free Society of Traders hath obtain'd a Warrant from y<sup>e</sup> Proprietary & Govern<sup>t</sup> bearing date y<sup>e</sup> 26<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> Mo 1682 to take up Their Purchase of Land being Twenty Thousand Acres, & since it was agreed, y<sup>t</sup> one fourth should be surveyd unto y<sup>m</sup> in y<sup>e</sup> County of Bucks: These are in y<sup>e</sup> Proprietarys Name to will & require thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be survey'd unto them y<sup>e</sup> five Thousand acres in y<sup>e</sup> aforemention'd County where not already taken up, they seating & improving y<sup>e</sup> same w<sup>th</sup> in six Months from y<sup>e</sup> Date of survey according to Regulation, & make returns thereof into y<sup>e</sup> Secretar<sup>y</sup>'s office Given at Philadelphia y<sup>e</sup> 17<sup>th</sup> 9<sup>th</sup> mo 1684
