

In Pursuance of a Warrant under the hands & Seals of Charles Read Job Goodson Evar Owen and George Fitzwater Trustees for the free Society of Traders to me directed bearing Date the fourth day of April 1724 empowering and Requiring me to Survey to John Jones Boulter six hundred acres of Land in part of 20000 acres purchased by the said Society This may certify that on the sixth day of April in the same year (1724) There was Surveyd to the said John Jones in part of the said six hundred acres a certain Tract of Land in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a Corner marked black oak and Running by the Land of Robert Ashton North West one hundred and nineteen perches to post Then by the Land reputed John Knights North East three hundred and ten perches to a post Then by the Land of Andrew Beadford and other Land South East two hundred seventy nine perches to a post Then by the Land of Benjamin Charlesworth south West eighty nine perches to a hickery sappling Then North West by Land of Jeremiah <sup>Hopton</sup> one hundred and sixty perches to a Corner white oak Then by the Land of the said Hopton Nicholas Steegletz and Edward farmer South West two hundred twenty one perches to the place of Beginning Containing three hundred and ten acres.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this second day of November, 1910.
