In pursuance of a warrant from under the hands and Seals of Charles Read Job Goodson Evan Owen and George Filzwater Trustees for the free Society of Traders to me directed bearing Date the fourth day of April 1724 empowering and requiring me to survey to John Jones Boulter Six hundred acres of Land in part of 2000 acres purchased by the said Society

This may Certifie that on the sixth day of April Anno 1724 there was Surveyd to the said John Jones in part of the said six hundred acres a certain Tract of Land in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a corner marked Black Oak and Running by the Land of Robert Ashton North West two hundred forty eight perches to a Spanish oak at a Corner of Abraham Daws Land then by the same North East three hundred and ten perches to a post then South East by Land of Edward Burk Andrew Bradford and another Tract four hundred and eight perches to a post then South West by Land of Benjamin Charlesworth eighty nine perches to a hickery sapling thence North West by Land of Jeremiah Hopton one hundred and sixty perches to a corner White Oak then by the Land of the said Hopton Nicholas Steegletz and Edward farmer South West two hundred twenty one perches to the place of Beginning Containing five hundred and sixty acres
