At the Request of Casper Wister that Wee would grant him to take up two small Parcels of Land adjoining to a Tract of his own at Shippack in the County of Philadelphia, the one Containing twenty six acres & a half, & the other four acres & sixty four perches for which he agrees to pay to our Use at the rate of fifteen pounds ten shillings current Money of this Province for One hundred acres and the Yearly Quit Rent of one half-penny sterling for every acre thereof; These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be surveyed unto the said Casper Wister at the place aforesaid the said two Parcels of Land & make Return thereof into the Secretary's Office for further Confirmation -- Given under my Hand and the lesser Seal of our Province, at Philadelphia this eighth Day of January Anno Dom. 1733
