



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Eighth day of January 1733 Requiring the Surveyor General to Survey or Cause to be surveyed to Casper Wister Two small tracts of Land in the County of Philad^a. There was Surveyed to the said Casper Wister on the Third day of April 1734 one of the said Tracts of Land Situate in the Township of Salford Beginning at a Spanish Oak thence by land of Gatchelick Gatchelick South East Sixty four perches to a post thence by land of William Pitts North East Eleven perches to a post thence by land of the said Casper Wister North West Sixty four perches to a post thence by Vac^t land South West Eleven perches to the place of Beginning Containing four acres with Usual Allowance of Six p Cent
