Upon the Settlement of Lawrence Grouden's amount of Lands &c a Warr^t was granted him the 24th Nov^r 1737 for 424^{ac} w^{ch} as Matters were then understood would compleat his Quantity, but since that time a Deed is found that takes away from him 106^{ac} of what was deemed Lawrences Share near Potquesin, in lieu whereof another Warr^t will be granted to Lawrence for 106^{ac} & all^o. But James Street being not yet returned from Kent it cannot be had today, in the mean time I desire thee to lay out to him 106^{ac} &c more than the Quantity mentioned in the Warr^t aforesaid & a Copy of another Warr^t shall be sent thee as soon as the Original comes to my Hands
