

Pennsylvania, ss,—

By Virtue of a Warrant Dated the fourteenth Day of November, 1741 there was surveyed on the 27th. Day of April, 1742 for the use of the Honourable the Proprietaries a certain Tract of Land Situate in the Forks of Delaware formerly in the County of Bucks, now in the County of Northampton Beginning at a post in a line of William Allen's Land and from thence extending by the same West Two hundred and forty seven perches to a post, thence by Vacant Land North fifty perches to a post North sixty eight Degrees East Two hundred and forty perches to a stone, and South ten Degrees East One hundred & forty two perches to the place of Beginning Containing One hundred and thirty four Acres and 103 ¹/₂ perches and the usual allowance of six Acres ¹/₄ Cent. for Roads &c^o. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 26th day of December, Anno Dom. 1754.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eleventh day of May, 1910.
