



Surveyed and laid out for James Steel A Tract of Land (being Part of his Purchase of Jno. Budd and Humphrey Morrey) Situate In the County of Philadelphia. Beginning at A Corner Post of Jno. Hagemans land thence by that and Andrew freys land South East four hundred perches to A Post thence North East Two hundred forty Six perches to a Post thence by Lands of Henry Grubb and Hans Nuse, North West Two hundred perches to A Post thence by Hans Nuse South West Eighty Perches to a Black oak Marked for A Corner then by sd Nuse's Land North West Two hundred perches to a Post thence by the Garman Tract South West One hundred Sixty and Six perches to the Place of beginning Containing five hundred and fifteen Acres.
