



By virtue of a warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the twenty eighth day of August 1719 There was Surveyed to James Steel in Right of Humphrey Murrey and John Budd a Tract of Land Situate in the Township of Salford in the County of Philada. Beginning at a white Oak being a Corner of a Tract of Land belonging to John Ledrah thence by Land of Jacob Colb South West forty two perches to a post. Thence by Bebbers Township North West Two hundred and two perches to a post thence by Land late of Rees Williams. North East forty two perches to a post thence by Land of sd. John Ledrah. South East Two hundred and two perches to the place of Beginning Containing Fifty Acres with the Usual Allowance of Six p. Cent.

Surveyed the 13th day of May 1727.
