At y^e Request of y^e undertimmed Persons, y^t their Purchase and Head Land might
be layd out above Nashametti Creek. These are to will and require thee forthwith
to Survey or cause to be Surveyd unto David Kittsey 100 Acres Purchase Land 100 Acres
head Land for himself and Wife and 100 Acres more upon Penn; To David Jones
100 Acres Purchase Land, and 100 Acres head land for himself & Wife; To Samuel
Miles 300 Acres Purchase Land; ^{& 1000 acres y^e head Land Purchased & paid for} ~~and 100 Acres head land for himself and Wife~~ To
Rich^d Miles 100 Acres (*obliterated*) Purchase Land in a place not
already taken up, & observing y^t already y^e head land be Surveyd behind y^e Purchase
Land, according to y^e Method of Townships appointed by me, and make returns
thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia y^e 19th of y^e 1st M^o 1683.

It is y^e Govern^r's pleasure, since y^e Quantities of y^e Purchasers are but small, y^t
they may have thrice y^e breadth in y^e front but half y^e length, if there be no Land
left on this side of y^e s^d Creek, it may be layd out elsewhere not taken up.
