

By Vertue of the Proprietaries warrant to me directed
 barein date the 17th day of the 6th moth. 1699 to survey
 and lay out Certain Lands and Lott for the Land Compa.
 of London I Certifye into the Genll. Surveyors office.
 that I have this day surveyed and Layed out their
 proportion within the City of Philadelphia & Land
 appropriated to that use viz: one front Lott bounded to
 the southward wth. Joseph Willcox Lott. — foote. with
 the second street westerly one hundred and two foote
 wth. vacant Lotts to the Northward — foote with the front
 street to the Eastward one hundred and two foote.
 Also wholly relinquishing their Schole Hill Lott.
 I have surveyed them Eight Lotts contiguous in Mulbery
 street begining on the sixth street from Delaware.
 Thence Eastward by the same three hundred and six
 foote Thence southward by the High street Lotts late
 belonging unto Capt. Tho. Holme & William Stanly three
 hundred ninty five foote. westward by vacant Lotts
 three hundred and six foote & Northward by the said
 Mulbery street three hundred Ninty five foote unto the
 place of Begining
