

This may Certifie that by virtue of a warrant from William ^{Penn} Proprietor and Governour of Pensilvania & to Thomas ffairman directed bearing Date the 17th of the 6th Month 1699 he the said Thomas did on the 17th of 8 br 1701 Survey for Tobias Collet Michael Fussel Daniel Quare and Henry Gouldney Purchas^{rs} of 6000 Acres of Land in this Province a Tract of Land in part thereof containing sixteen thousand and five hundred acres situate above & on the back of New castle County which Survey was Returned into and now is in the Surveyr. Genls. Office in Philadelphia. Thomas ffairman Surveyd of the said 6000 acres 47129 acres after his Decease Richard Hill ^{dat 188 br 1716} Isaac Norris & James Logan Issued their warrantⁿ for Surveying the Complement twelve thousand eight hundred seventy one acres in Pursuance whereof Isaac Taylor Surveyor of the County of Chester added to the above Tract seven hundred twenty four acres and made a Return of the whole Seventeen thousand two hundred twenty four acres in the said County of Chester.
