

Beginning at a Corner marked Red Oak Standing neare White Clay  
 Creek on ye side of a Great Hill neare the Line of Latitia Penns  
 Mannor thence by a Line of marked Trees west 380 per to a Corner  
 marked Chesnut Tree of Thomas Wild. & Companys Land then  
 with their Line South 440 per to a a Cor. mar Red Oak then with  
 another of ye sd Wilds & Companys Land west 400 per to a Cor  
 mar Red Oak of ye sd Wilds & Companys Land Standing in a Line  
 of a Tract of Land belonging to ye London Company.  
 South 704 per to a Cor mar Red Oak & Continuing ye same Course 44  
 per to a Cor mar White Oak then by a Line of marked Trees East 340

 Clay Creek then up by ye sd Creek side N. 32<sup>d</sup> Wly 92 per N. 62<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub><sup>d</sup> Wly  
 10 per N. 49<sup>d</sup> Wly 32 per. N. 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub><sup>d</sup> Wly 91 per. to a Cor white Oak stand  
 neare White Clay Cree in one of ye Lines of Latitia Penns Mannor  
 then with ye sd Mannor Line W. 56 per to a Cor marked White Oak  
 Standing neare ye Side of a Branch of White Clay Creek then with  
 anothe of ye sd mannor Lines N. 380 perches to ye first mentioned  
 Red oak Conteyning & Layed out for 3700 Acres of Land Surveyed  
 ye 17 day of ye 8 month 1707. P. Tho. Pierson.
