


Pensilvania 5s.



By the Commissioners of Property

At the request of James Shattick of the County of Philadelphia that we would grant him to take up in ye liberties of Philadelphia the proportion of liberty land belonging to the original purchase of five hundred acres of land made of the Propriet<sup>t</sup> by Joan Dixon<sub>n</sub> and also that a former Warrant granted<sub>n</sub> for laying out the City lott in right of the same purchase might be according to the tennor thereof executed. These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said James Shattick within the said liberties of Philadelphia the said proportion of liberty land appurtenant to the said purchase and also to execute the said Warrant for the aforesaid lott according to the purport thereof & make returns of the whole into the Secretary's office in order for a further confirmation.
