These are to authorize and require thee forthwith to survey and lay out ~~to~~ to the s^d John Harper the s^d number of five acres of land within the bounds of the Liberties afores^d ~~where~~ ^{surveyed} on the West side of Skuylkill where not already taken up nor ~~conceded or~~ ^{Surveyor Generals} ~~settled by the Indians~~ and make returns into the ~~Secretarys~~ office. ~~Given~~ at Philad^{ia} where this Warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary.
