In pursuance of a Warrant from the Commissionerto me di-  
 rected bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> day of the 11<sup>th</sup> month Anno \_\_\_\_\_  
 1726 requireing me <sup>to survey</sup> to Isaac Norris one and twenty acres of  
 land in the liberties of Philadelphia to make up a deficiency  
 in the tract where he dwells. This may certifie that on the  
 28<sup>d</sup> day of the same month I surveyd for the said Isaac Nor-  
 ris a piece of land in the said Liberties beginning at a post  
 in a line of other land of the s<sup>d</sup> Isaac Norris and at a corner  
 of William Carters land thence running South South East  
 by the said William Carters land two hundred and forty  
 perches to a post then West South West fourteen perches to a post  
 then by land of the said Isaac Norris North North West two hundred  
 and forty perches to a post then East North East by land of the said  
 Isaac Norris fourteen perches to the place of beginning contain-  
 ing twenty one acres

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in  
 the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made  
 conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
