By the Proprietaries

At the request of Isaac Norris of Fair Hill Esq^r that we would grant him to take up about fifty acres of land in the Welch tract adjoining to William William's land in the County of Chester for which He agrees to pay to our use at ye rate of fifteen pounds ten shillings current money of this Province for one hundred acres, and the yearly quit-rent of one half-penny sterling for every acre thereof.

These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said Isaac Norris at the place aforesaid, according to the method of townships appointed, the said quantity of about 50 acres that hath not been already survey'd or appropriated, and make return thereof into the Secretary's office, in order for a further confirmation; which survey, in case the said Isaac Norris fulfil the above agreement within six months from the date hereof, shall be valid, otherwise to be void.

Given under my hand, and the lesser Seal of our Province, at Philadelphia, this 30th day of April Anno Dom. 1734.
