



This Tract Surveyed at Old Laweck Beginning at a marked hickry standing on the south point of the Island then by the east side of the Island to the head thereof and over an Inlett of water then upp the several courses of the west side of the branch to a marked hickry for a corner then west sixty cheans over a small-branch to a whit-oak then south one hundred and twenty four cheans by vacant Land to a larg-Spanish oak forked standing on the south sid- by a larg-branch then east sixty cheans to a post by the side of the west branch belo- the point of the Island to across to the place of begining containing seven hundred and forty four acres surveyed in Bucks County the 6- of the 8- month 1733.
