At the Request of Jacob Kreyter now of the Township of Strasburg in this Province That we would Grant him to take up in or near the s<sup>d</sup> Township the quantity of Two hundred & fifty acres of Land for which he agrees to pay to the Proprietors Use ffive & twenty pounds money of the said Province on or before the ffive and twentieth day of March next ensuing the date hereof for the whole and the yearly Quitrent of one Shilling Sterling for each hundred Acres and in proportion for the ffifty acres. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto the said Jacob Kreyter in or near the place aforesaid according to the Method of Townships appointed the said quantity of Two hundred & fifty acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by y<sup>e</sup> Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office. Which Survey in case the said Jacob fulfill y<sup>e</sup> above Agreement shall be Valid otherwise the same is to be Void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever Granted.
