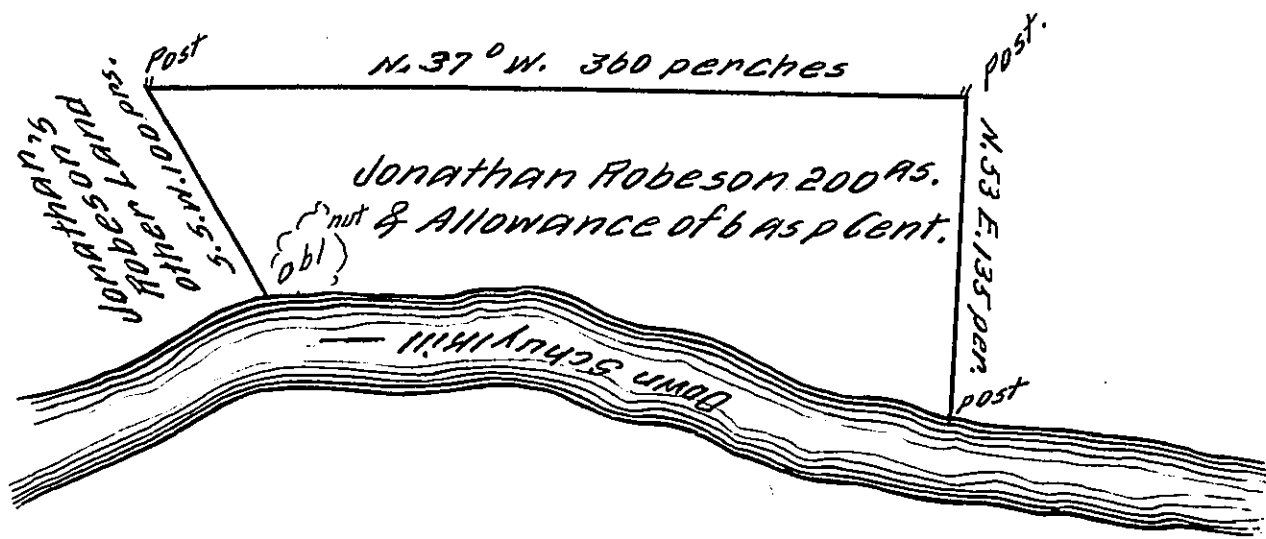


## A Barren Mountain.
