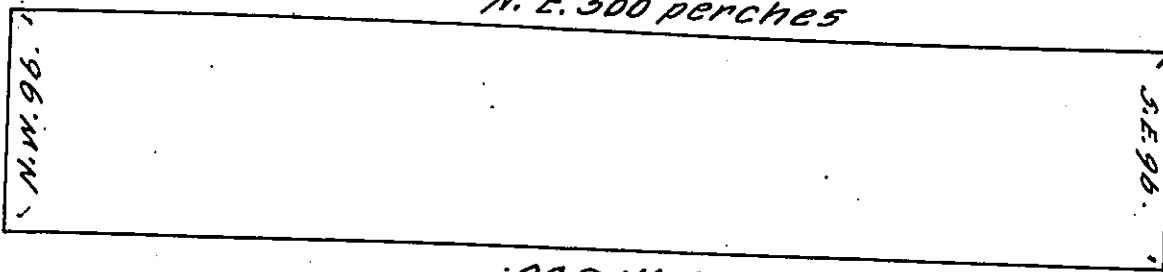

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of March 1733, there was laid out to James Steel a Certain Tract of Land Situate in the Township of Limerick in the County of Philada. Beginning at a Post being a Corner of Humphrey Murrays land thence by the same North East five hundred perches to a Post thence South East Ninety Six perches to a Post thence South West by land late of Jonathan Dickinson Deceased five hundred perches to a Post thence by Land of the London Company North West Ninety Six perches to the Place of Beginning. Containing three hundred Acres.
