

Surveyed the 28th day of December 1730 by virtue of a  
warrant dated the 30th day of October 1730. unto James  
Steel of the City Philadelphia a certain lot of ground in  
the said City [in Right of William Boswell's Purchase of  
500 acres) lying between Sassafras Street and Vine  
Street bounded westward with the third Street from  
Delaware on the North with other Ground of the said  
James Steel on the East with the Ends of Second Street  
Lots And on the South with said James Steels lot in Right  
of Joseph and Daniel Milner being in Breadth on the  
said third Street one hundred & thirty three feet And  
in Length One hundred ninety five feet Returned into  
the Secretary's Office the 22d of January 1730  
by Jacob Taylor.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in  
the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made  
conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
