

By virtue of the Commissioners Warrant Dated the tenth day of the Second Month 1718 for Laying out to James Steel of Philadelphia Gent. Several pieces of Land in the Liberties of the said City vizt Eight acres in Right of John Martin & four in Right Hen Child four acres in Right of Edmond Lovet; four acres in Right of Henry Stevens and Eight acres in Right of Thomas Dell the said James Steel is Invested with the Right unto, This May Certifie that on the 12th day of the third Month in the year 1718 there was Surveyd and Layd out to the said James Steel in the said Liberties One Tract or Parcel of Land Beginning at a Post in a line of William Palmers Land and at a Corner of Thomas Shoot's Land Thence by the said Shoots Land South South East sixty two perches to a post. Then West South West Seventy two perches and one quarter of a perch to a post Then North north west sixty two perches to a Post Then by the said William Palmers Land East north East Seventy two perches and one quarter of a perch to the Place of Beginning Containing the sum of the above Mentioned quantities vizt twenty eight Acres. Returned into the Secretary's Office
May the 19 Anno 1718.
