This tract has been duly surveyed according to the original lines and marks on the ground - in pursuance of the actual settlement of William Lindsey, who it appears commenced his settlement in the fall of eighteen hundred and thirteen is now residing thereon with his family and engaged in improving and cultivating the same when this survey was made on Nov. 2<sup>d</sup> A. D. 1826.
