



In pursuance of an order from the Commissioners of Property dated the 16th of June, 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the Co^{ty} of Northumberland being numbered in the general plan of said Town One hundred and forty two, and granted to Alexander Grant, containing in breadth East and West Sixty feet and in length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet, bounded Westward by Lot No. 143 Northward by Cranberry Street, Eastward by Lot No. 141 and Southward by Strawberry Alley, as by the general plan of said Town remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear.
