



The above is a draft of a survey made upon an undrawn tract of donation land, situate in Delaware Township, in Mercer County, surveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> day of August 1828 according to the original lines, marks and corners on the ground, for Alexander Nicol, in pursuance of an actual settlement, residence and improvement, made thereon at an early date, and continued on until the present time, on this tract there is a large improvement and Alext. Nicol residing on, and improving the same at the time it was surveyed. This tract is bounded by land, numbered as above described. It is numbered in the general draft of the 4<sup>th</sup> district of donation N<sup>o</sup>. 825. and contains two hundred and five acres, and allowance for roads &c.
