



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property bearing date the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland, being numbered in the general plan of said Town one hundred and thirty two and granted to Benjamin Allison, Esqr. containing in length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet and in Breadth East and West Sixty feet, Bounded Westward by River Street, Northward by Strawberry Alley, Eastward by Lot N° 131 and Southward by Dewberry Street as by the general plan remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear.
