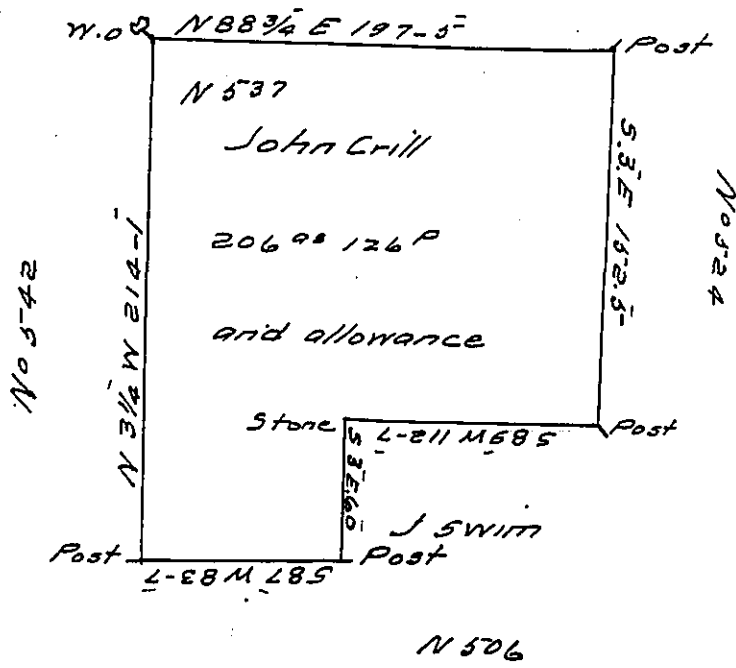

Surveyed this 17th day of January 1825. Containing two hundred and six acres and 126 perches with the usual allowance of six per Cent, For John Crill in whom the equitable ^{title} is now vested.
