



In pursuance of an order from the Commissioners of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in the general plan of said Town Forty six, and granted to Jonathan Lodge (who assigned the same to Charles Gough) containing in breadth East & West Sixty feet and in length North & South Two hundred and thirty feet, bounded Westward by Lot number Forty Seven Southward by Shamokin Street, Eastward by Lot number Forty five and Northward by Mulberry Alley, as by the general Plan of said Town remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 5th day of January, 1773.
