



A Plan of a Lot of Ground situate on the South Side of High Street and West side of Water Street in the Town of York containing in Breadth on Water Street fifty seven feet and an half and in length to Codorus Creek two hundred and fifteen feet Bounded Northward with High Street aforesaid Eastward with Water Street aforesaid Southward with a Lot of Ground in the Tenure of Jacob Doudle and marked on the General Plan of the said Town Number One hundred and thirty eight and Westward with Codorus Creek

Entered on the Plan of the said Town and Surveyed for Jacob Doudle who has built an House thereon according to the Conditions of Settling the Town

Certified at York the 2^d day of April 1759 -
