



A Plan of a Lot of Ground situate on the West Side of Water Street in the Town of York containing in Breadth on Water Street fifty seven feet and an half in length to Codorus Creek two hundred and thirty feet Bounded Eastward with Water Street aforesaid Southward with a twenty feet Alley Westward with Codorus Creek and Northward with a Lot of Ground in the Tenure of Jacob Doudle and mark on the General Plan of the said Town Number one hundred and thirty nine.

Entered on the Plan of the said Town and Surveyed for Jacob Doudle who has built an House thereon according to the Conditions of Settling the Town—

Certified at York the 2<sup>d</sup> day of April 1759
