

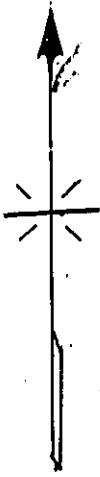

being part of a larger tract containing Four hundred (400)  
acres, no perches and allowance, originally surveyed in pur-  
suance of a warrant granted to John Nicholson dated the  
31<sup>st</sup> day of March 1794.
