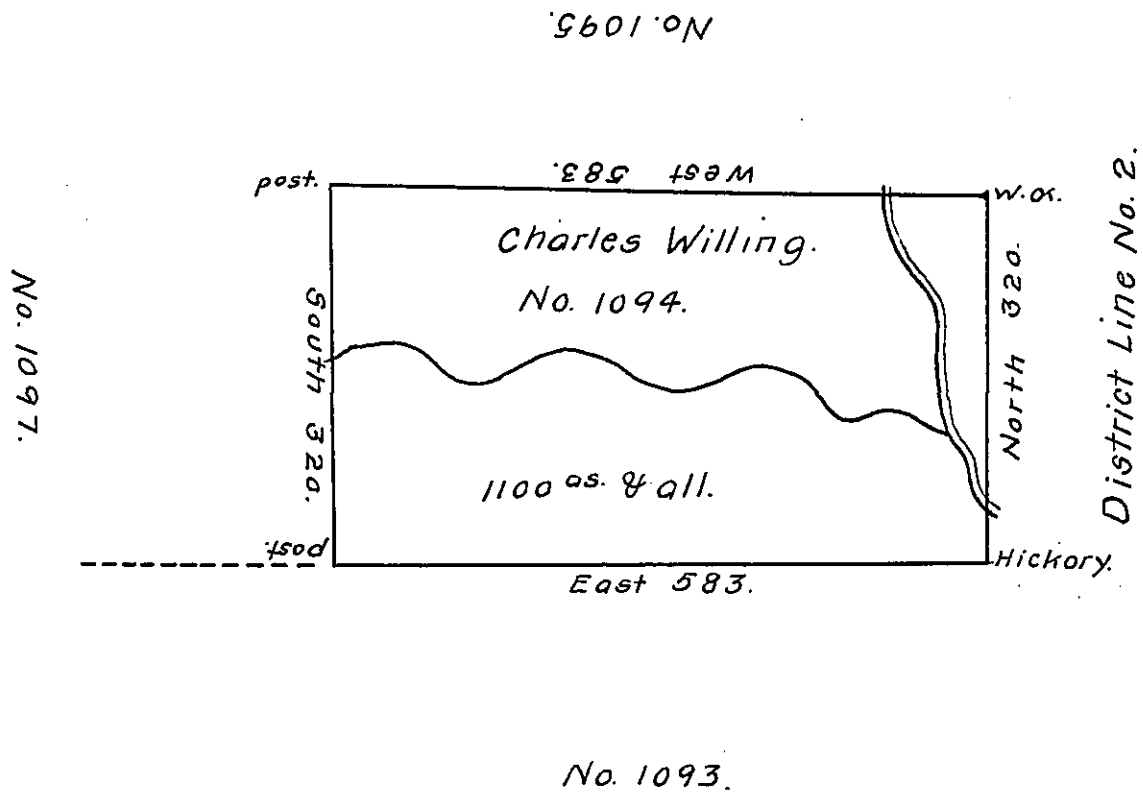

Situate about one mile and three Quarters North of the West Branch of Susquehanna River and about one Mile and a half North West of the Salt Lick in North<sup>d</sup> County containing 1100<sup>ac</sup> and the usual allowance for Roads. Surveyed July 18<sup>th</sup> 1793 for Charles Willing in persuance of a Warrant No. 1094. Dated the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1792.
