



The above are two surveys I made the beginning of Novem^r 1750 for John Hillman, at the request of John McMickle.

To the best of my remembrance McMickle obtain'd another warrant besides the one above mentioned, and having sold 150^{as} part of the tract surveyed on the first ^{cont^d 197 1/4} to one Mathew Rowe (tho Rowe has not that quantity) concluded to have the remainder with the addition, returned in one tract on the last warrant.
