



The Draught of a Tract of Land called Patterson's Discovery situate on the East Branch of the standing stone creek in the County of Cumberland, containing Three Hundred Eighty Five Acres and One Hundred Fifty Four Perches with usual allowance of six Acres P. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 10th day of September A.D. 1766. In presence of an Order to Survey Benezet bearing date at Philad^a. the 1st day of August 1766 and numbered 46. To John Luke Esq.
