Situate on the South side the West Branch of Susquehanna River formerly in the County of Berks now Northumberland allotted and surveyed for Captain Timothy Green being part of a large tract, surveyed in the months of March & April 1769 for the officers of the first & second Battallion of the Pennsylvania Reg^t.
