



Situate in Lower Mahantongo Township Schuylkill County surveyed to John Beckly on the first day of January A.D. 1820 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Ulrich Beckly dated the seventh day of August 1793.

Unimproved stony land and thinly covered with timber, not sufficient land embraced under the Warrant to reach Henry Bonner's land is called for in the Warrant. No trace of the spring which was dry having crossed the line, but it was said that after a few meanders it sunk before reaching the line.
