



Surveyed to William Smith on the 23^d day of March 1785 the above described tract of three hundred & forty one acres & one tenth of an acre & allowance of six p. Cent. Situate about three miles eastward of the Kittaning upon a run which empties into Cowanshannock creek a few perches above where it is crossed by the Purchase line the land extending back along the said line & up the run chiefly on the southerly side of said run in Westmoreland County. By warrant of the 7th day of Feby. 1776.
