 We the Commissioners for adjusting the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongohala, Yohogania and Ohio do hereby certify that Thomas Armor is intitled to four hundred acres of Land in the County of Yohogania situate on the Waters of Raccoon to include his improvement made in the year 1776.
 Given under our hands at Cox's Fort the 4th day of February 1780 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth,
