Situate on Conanawango Creek in Little Britain Township Lancaster County was Survey'd in Pursuance of four Warrants whose Dates are as follows. Viz^t The Large Piece Described by C. Containing ~~54 1/2~~ ^{26 7/12} & allowance was Survey'd in Pursuance of a warrant first Granted to William Trelton Dated July 21st 1734 & Resurvey'd to James Gillespie by Warrant Dated ~~19th of March 1743~~ ^{19th of March 1743}
 2nd by The 56^{1/2} Described by A was Survey'd by Warrant Dated 19th of March 1743
 3rd by The 42^{1/4} Described by B was Survey'd 13th of 4th mo 1749 by Warrant Dated July 4th 20th 1748
 4th & lastly The 53^{3/4} Described above by D was Survey'd in Pursuance of a Warrant Dated ~~17th of March 1743~~ ^{in the year 1749 say 20th March 1748}
 Date. But Looking in the Warrant I found it out put in, but left blank I suppose thro' a mistake
 Containing in all 54 6^{1/2} & the allowance of 6^{1/2} Cent. for Roads & Highways
 The 126^{1/4} & the 56^{1/4} both Returned into the Secretary's Office the 20th May 1774
