



Situate In Trough Creek Valley in Union Township Huntingdon County - containing Two Hundred and fifty six acres and Allowance of six percent - Surveyed 23<sup>rd</sup> day of November 1783 on Warrant granted to Christopher Reiter dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of November 1774 - No 1 represented by dotted lines is the draught of a tract of Land Surveyed for Wilkinson Lane on Warrant dated the 9<sup>th</sup> day of November 1784. This tract interferes fifty three acres with the Christopher Reiter Survey - Wilkinson Lane conveyed to Henry Barkstrasser Esqr the present owner. The other dotted lines represent the draught of a tract of land surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May 1785 on Warrant granted to Azariah Mc Lane dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 1785 - this tract interferes two hundred and three acres with the Christopher Reiter Survey - Azariah McClaun devised the same to John M C Clain, the present owner.
