ing Three Hundred and Ninety Five Acres Surveyed <sup>March 21 1785</sup> for Thomas Slater on a Virginia Cer-  
tificate as follows. Viz:

We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties  
of Monongalia, Yohogania and the Ohio do hereby Certify that Thomas Slater is intitled to  
four Hundred Acres of land in Monongalia County on Ten Mile Creek to include his  
Actual Settlement Made in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and  
Seventy one

Given under our hands at Coopers for the Twentieth Day of January 1780 in the  
fourth Year of the Commonwealth

Owner obtained a warrant for it dated
