



The above diagram shows the intersection of a survey made the 4th day of July 1770 in the name of Hugh Crawford in pursuance of a ^{grant of preference} dated January 22^d 1768 and another survey made September 15th 1769 in the name of Philip Shute in pursuance of order No. 31481 dated June 14th 1769 situate in the then new purchase Cumberland county now Union township Fayette county containing in all 556 acres and three quarters & allowance.
