Containing as above set forth 283.2 & 69 perches and allowance of 6 percent &c Originally Surveyed In Pursuance of a Warrant for 250.0<sup>a</sup> Granted to Henry Swaney dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1742. Resurveyed by the old lines the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1814, at the request of Francis Wilson and Alexander M. Curdy Executors of the Estate of Andrew Wilson deceased, who desired the same to be Returned for Confirmation.
