



The above Draught represents an Island (called "Middle Island") in the Susquehanna river, in Manor township, Lancaster county. Containing One acre and twenty six perches, strict measure, lying outside of the Main Conestoga Island, and about a fourth of a mile from the Lancaster County shore. — Surveyed October 16th 1860. in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 6th day of September 1859. granted to James Hudtson
