



By virtue of a Warrant granted to Hugh Black dated the 5th day of February 1744 surveyed for Thomas Black on the 31st day of December 1765 by Bartram Galbraith late Deputy Surveyor as appears by his Official Draught remaining in my Office the above described Tract of one hundred and Twenty three Acres and a half and allowance to situate in Deerey Township then Lancaster County, now in the County of Dauphin, being part of three hundred and ninety five acres surveyed unto said Hugh Black - Certified this 19th of March 1803 -
